First, they don’t pray to impress others. Second, they are straightforward and unashamed of their bold requests. Third, they are simple and sincere. Children pray about what they care about. Authenticity, simplicity, and spontaneity are hallmarks of childlike prayer and faith.

Prayer is the key to living with hope. Jesus said that we “should always pray and never give up.” Children who pray are less likely to be discouraged by life. That’s why it’s important to strengthen the hope of children by introducing them to Jesus’ model for prayer at an early age.

It is my prayer for you that reading this book with your children and praying the Lord’s Prayer together will become a meaningful bedtime ritual, a treasured memory, and a lasting legacy that bears good fruit for generations to come. May God bless you and the children you love.
